Fitchburg was first settled in 1740 and became incorporated by John Fitch in 1764. It has a great locationin north Central Massachusetts being close to New Hampshire and 50 miles from Boston. The city of Fitchburg offers a small town feel with the busy city nearby that offers an abundance of amenities and resources. The city has excellent access via highway or MBTA commuter train. Fitchburg is home to Fitchburg State University and offers a wide variety of academic programs. Fitchburg offers a great school system along with numerous resources, amenities and services to those who live and work in Fitchburg.

The former reliance on the paper industry in the community has given way to a healthier economic diversification which now includes pharmaceuticals, tool and die makers, machine manufacturers, plastic molders and textile producers. Services (utilities, health care, education, and business services) now account for the largest share of employment, followed by manufacturing and trade




